Emergency Closure to Vessels and Watercraft

Order of the Commissioner of Conservation & Natural Resources in conjunction with the City of Orange Beach and the US Coast Guard in response to the BP / Deepwater Horizon Oil Spill

Alabama Waters to the west and south from the southern tip of Bear Point to the entrance to Ono Harbor are closed to recreational boating, recreational fishing vessels and watercraft with the exception of emergency response vessels, governmental operations and other approved response vessels.

The closed areas are: all Alabama waters South of a line running from the southernmost tip of Bear Point to Ono Harbor on Ono Island. This will include Bayou St. John, Terry Cove, Terry Cove Harbor, Cotton Bayou, Perdido Pass and all canals entering these waters.

This action will allow boom and skimmer strategy to work effectively in collecting approaching oil from the Gulf of Mexico through Perdido Pass
